

National Awards Success!

The Elmscot Group was shortlisted for 3 categories in the annual national Nursery World Awards, held on the 23rd of September at the Brewery in London: Inclusive Practice, Practitioner of the Year and Early Years Teacher of the Year.

Elmscot Day Nursery won the Inclusive Practice Award, recognized for how every child is treated as an individual. The setting SENCO, Ami Mahon, said: "I work closely with all practitioners, for example, supporting them with specific areas of child development or ensuring cultural diversity is represented." Elmscot currently looks after several children with additional educational needs and has developed strong relationships with external professionals such as speech and language therapists, physiotherapists and sensory support services.

Alex Chiorando – Early years education manager for the Elmscot Group, was one of two finalists for Early Years Teacher of the Year and Ami Mahon was runner-up in Practitioner of the Year. Congratulations to our colleagues on their success.

Elmscot in China

In September, Elmscot was invited to be part of a Department for International Trade visit to Beijing, Shanghai and Shenzhen. The purpose was to represent British Values and discuss our superb EYFS with Chinese schools, nurseries, educational sector developers and statutory bodies.

Stephanie Molnar, one of Elmscot's Directors, took part in the initiative along with 15 other UK providers. The week-long event was hosted by the British Embassy in Beijing and Stephanie was able to discuss how the UK (and Elmscot in particular) could work with Chinese colleagues to improve Early Years Education provision in China with Antonia Romeo, Permanent Secretary of the DIT. Since then, we have welcomed 16 primary age students from Beijing to Kids Collective October Holiday Club this half-term...word of our service has spread far and wide!

Teachers at Elmscot



The Elmscot Group are proud to employ qualified early years teachers across all of our nursery settings. Across the group we currently have 13 working directly with the children and an additional 2 Early Years teachers supporting best practise across the group.

We know that during the early years a child's brain is developing at its quickest rate - and that language and communication skills are the building blocks for everything else they will learn, including subjects like maths and sciences. Our teachers are specially trained to facilitate this, using many different methods to support all children's differing learning styles. We don't waste a second in nursery, every little routine enables the children to expand their vocabulary and enquiry skills.

Crucially, the Early Years teachers provide the children with the tools they need to build their self-esteem and confidence, and develop positive relationships with everyone around them. They also work closely with the practitioners to develop their skills in these areas, thus providing highly skilled teams.

In Preschool, our teachers are supernumerary and work alongside the highly qualified practitioner teams. The teachers work closely with the team to assess and plan for the children's interests. They use the EYFS framework and the government phonics strategy Letters and Sounds to deliver focused maths, literacy and phonics sessions. They are highly qualified and deliver learning intentions through children's play and interests. This ensures that the children are focused and therefore absorb more.

All of our Early Years Specialists are kept up to date with the latest research and advice in the field. They regularly attend training provided externally or by our EYFS designated Manager who is a qualified teacher and early years specialist.

We are very honoured to be currently working with the Early Years and Childhood Studies Team at MMU. Lyndsey Schofield, Level 4 Lead Lecturer will be working with the teams as part of a research project for a Doctorate in Education. We are very excited about working with the experts in the Early Years sector.
